## Summary

The name *Ystad*

Since yew pollen is not found in a pollen analysis covering six millennia in the Ystad area, it is unlikely that Old Danish y 'yew tree' provided the first element of the name Ystad. The present writer proposes \*Yzt + stad 'the outermost habitation towards the sea' as the explanation for the name of the small coastal village from the Vendel Age that was discovered in archaeological excavations a couple of hundred metres from the present shoreline.
