Kesebro in Lerbo

Many Scandinavian place-names in -bro contain the name of a river or stream as their first element. One such name is probably the farm name Kesebro (kesabro 1381) in Lerbo parish, Södermanland. Kese- may be assumed to be related to the Scandinavian word stem *keis- 'to bend'. The first element could conceivably refer to an elevation near the bridge that has given its name to the settlement, but the most likely explanation is that Kese- contains an old name for the river Fimtaån, meaning 'the winding river, the bent river' or the like.
